Health insurance requirements	Students must have an international health insurance plan with coverage in Mexico, during all their stay, and they must have a credit or debit card to pay for medical expenses, since most medical insurance reimburse after a claim has been filed. Proof of coverage must be provided upon arrival.
Cost of living (USD approx./ per month)	\$700 including housing, food, transportation, cell phone and other expenses.
Pick-up service	La Salle Morelia does not offer pick up service upon arrival, students should use an authorized taxi from airport or bus station.

Only applications submitted by the home university, by mail or e-mail, will be processed.
